





Introducing HSR Seeds 78CRM silage maize.

A short maturity hybrid that is ideal for either silage or grain. Triton has a semi-dent kernel and is a plant with large leaf area and good stay-green. It has shown very good leaf blight resilience over the last two seasons and the ability to deliver above-average yields for both silage and grain. Triton is bred to perform under dryland conditions, with genetics selected for water use efficiency. A high 'grain to stover' ratio delivers high quality silage in a short growing season.

85,000 to **110,000** seeds/ha (GRAIN 75-100K)



Plant type:

78CRM dual purpose silage or grain.



Yield potential:

Excellent yields with a solid disease package.



Plant height:

Medium plant height with a great root structure.



Grain type:

Dent x Flint. Highly digestible feed grain. High starch content in grain and silage.
